# Reading



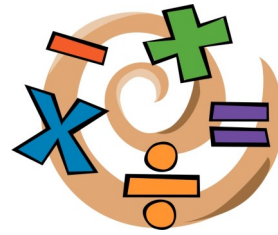
- = Read and understand simple sentences.
- = Use phonic knowledge to decode regular words and read them aloud accurately.
- = Read some common irregular words.
- = Demonstrate understanding when talking with others about what they have read.

## Writing



- = Use phonic knowledge to write words in ways which match their spoken sounds.
- = Write some irregular common words.
- = Write simple sentences which can be read by themselves and others.
- = Spell some words correctly and others are phonetically plausible.

## Mathematics



- Count reliably to 20.
- Count a number of objects by pointing to/ moving each one as they count.
- Recognise numbers to 20.
- Order numbers 1 – 20.
- Say 1 more and 1 less than numbers to 20.
- Add and subtract two single digit numbers.
- Form all digits 0-9 correctly.
- Know the names of the days of the week in order.
