

## Base 3 Class information for parents 2019



<b>Class teacher:</b>	Miss Starr
<b>Teaching assistants:</b>	Miss Head - mornings. Base 3 & 4
<b>PPA</b>	PPA is covered by Mrs Taylor
<b>Homework</b>	<p>Homework is sent on a Friday and should be returned to school by the following Wednesday. Each week children will be sent their homework book containing a task consisting of either a writing, maths, or topic activity. Also a list of spellings to learn for a test the following week. All children have a home reading record and a two school reading books. These are sent out on a Tuesday and collected in on a Monday. It is expected that children read at home 5 times per week. This only needs to be for a short amount of time and should be recorded in their reading records and signed by an adult.</p> <p>These records are checked in school. Children who read 5 times each week for the half term will be given a special 'golden afternoon' treat.</p>
<b>Rewards</b>	<p>We use 'Marvellous Me' to celebrate children's achievements throughout the week. Please ensure you are signed up to 'Marvellous Me'.</p> <p>Each week the school celebrates children as 'Star of the week'. This takes place during Friday assembly and certificates are sent home.</p> <p>WowMoji notes link to our 'YoiMoji' values. Parents can send 'WowMoji notes' into school when children have demonstrated one of the YoiMoji values at home (e.g. patient, independent, brave).</p>
<b>Phonics &amp; spelling</b>	<p>Phonics or spelling are taught daily in mixed groups across KS1. Children will be taught the phonic sounds or spelling rules that they need to focus on by either Mr Naik, Miss Walton, Miss Starr, Miss Poilblanc, Mrs Taylor and Miss Head. Phonics is assessed termly. The Year 1 phonics screening test will be in the week commencing 8<sup>th</sup> June 2020.</p>
<b>PE</b>	<p>PE takes place on Tuesday afternoons and Thursday mornings.</p> <p>Jewellery must not be worn for any PE activities. Children should ensure they have tracksuit / hoodies as PE will still be outside in light rain and cooler weather.</p>

	<i>If your child is unable to participate in PE, a message should be sent to the office or discussed with the class teacher.</i>
<i>Lost property</i>	<i>Please ensure all clothing is clearly labelled. This includes PE kits and water bottles.</i>
<i>Tuck</i>	<i>In KS1, children are given fruit every day.</i>
<i>Water</i>	<i>Children are encouraged to drink water throughout the day. All children need a labelled water bottle in class that they can refill when needed.</i>
<i>Collections</i>	<i>Please collect your child from the Base 3 door, where the KS1 children come into school. Please ensure staff know who is collecting your child each day. If someone else is collecting, please inform the office or class teacher.</i>
