Dear Parents and Carers

In line with government guidance, Perton Primary Academy will be open for Nursery, Reception and Year 1 from Monday 1 June. This letter will give you information so that you can decide whether to take up this offer.

- We will provide Reception/Year One children with a free packed lunch (no hot dinners), where required.
- Please provide children with a packed lunch and a water bottle. This includes children in Nursery who use the 30 hour provision.
- Children who are in receipt of Free school meals and who currently collect food parcels, will continue to do so – please look out for a text.
- Children must only bring their packed lunch and water bottle into school. No other equipment will be allowed.
- Be punctual when dropping off and collecting.

As a reminder:

- o Reception Red Group - arrival will be 8.45am and collection 3.05pm – Base 1 Entrance – Mrs Place
- o Reception Blue Group - arrival will be 8.45am and collection 3.05pm – Base 3 Entrance – Mrs Ives /Mrs Darbey (Infant entrance onto corridor)
- o Reception Green Group – arrival will be 9:00am and collection 3:20pm – Base 4 entrance (Year 1 canopy door) Miss Walton
- o Year 1 Yellow group - arrival will be 8.45am and collection 3.05pm - Base 5/6 Entrance (Canopy area) Miss Starr
- o Year 1 Purple group – arrival will be 9:00 am and collection 3:20pm Base 5/6 Entrance (Canopy area) Miss Poilblanc
- o Year 1 Orange group – arrival will be 8:45am and collection 3:05pm (Junior door on playground)
- o Key Workers group – Arrival FROM 8am and collection up to 4:30pm Base 10 (Base 10 entrance off staff carpark)

All groups will be taught in separate classrooms and where possible will use separate entrances or have staggered start/finishes. See signage on the day.

- Please socially distance when on the school site at all times

- Only one adult can accompany or collect your child/ children to and from school.
- Where possible, pass messages to school via Dojo rather than speaking to an adult on the gate.
- Provide the school with plenty of notice if children are not attending, or if you decide that you want your child to start attending.
- Send children into school in their uniform where possible.
- Make sure that the office has up to date contact details. This includes mobile phone numbers and home address.
- Please contact Mrs Small or the office on Dojo if you have any questions.

Home Learning will continue for years 2, 3 and 4. For Nursery, Reception and Year 1, staff will continue to post websites and more open ended activities for you to complete at home, however feedback will be less frequent.

You will receive a Dojo and Marvellous Me message stating which group your child has been allocated today.

Finally, thank you for your support over the last few weeks. The work that you have completed at home with the children and posted on Seesaw and Tapestry has been fantastic. The staff have also loved chatting over the phone and hearing about all the activities that the children have been completing.

We look forward to seeing many of you on June 1st.
