Dear Parents and Carers,

Welcome to Perton Middle School

We are delighted that you have chosen Perton Middle School for your child and we are looking forward to working in partnership with you on the next stage of your child's educational journey.

This year transition will look very different to previous years. Our school is currently only open to Year 6 and the children of key workers, however, we feel it is very important to offer our new Year 5 the chance to visit us and meet their form teacher. We hope that by having some time in school and meeting a friendly face the students can approach September with confidence. We do not underestimate the anxiety that some parents will have about allowing their children to come into school and we fully respect each family's right to choose what is right for them and their family. With that in mind, if you decide not to take up the offer of a transition visit we will send a pack of information to you. We will also be making a number of resources available online, this will include the enhanced transition packs for our SEND students.

The plan for transition this year is as follows:

On **Wednesday 24th June** there will be an online transition evening which will be available from 5pm. To join us please log onto:

This will include welcome speeches and uniform information. You can log on at a time to suit you however the session will be available from 5pm. As part of this evening we will ask you to complete an online data form. Once this form is completed, it will tell you which form your child has been put into. It will also tell you when your child's transition session is. As we are not expecting Y4 to be in their first school on this day, we will ask you to bring them directly to us and collect directly from us at the end of their short session. We have staggered the form times so students are in small groups and having the different schools on different sessions means we limit the risk of cross contamination. In an attempt to maintain social distancing, we will ask you to use the Pavilion carpark on Gainsborough Drive to ensure a smooth and appropriately distanced transition. We will meet your child at the school gate, we know that it is very tempting to stay and watch them come into school but we would ask you to help us keep the pavement outside school as clear as possible. At the end of the session their form teacher will bring them out of school and walk them down to the carpark. Pick up can be either from the pavement outside school or the Pavilion carpark.

At these sessions we will give the students a transition pack. For any students who are unable to attend there will be a virtual tour on our website along with short meet the form teacher videos and we will post out the transition packs.

For those children who will be joining us please arrive in your current school uniform. Please do not bring any personal belongings. We will provide each student with a bottle of water.

We are all looking forward to welcoming the new students and thank you for your support in ensuring a successful transition from their current school.
