



Dear Parents,

As you may be aware, the Government announced last week that schools no longer have to open to all pupils before the summer holidays. Instead, schools have the option to bring back children in smaller class sizes, if possible. Having looked at the capacity within school currently, we are able to offer a limited number of places in school for the remaining weeks of the summer term to children in Y2, Y3 and Y4 from Monday 22<sup>nd</sup> June.

To support us in making further plans, we need parents to contact us on Wednesday 17<sup>th</sup> June to request a place for their child in Y2, Y3 or Y4. Parents of children in Nursery, Reception and Y1 do not need to contact school. If you are a key worker or parent of a vulnerable child who has not used your child's place previously, you need to contact us. If you are a key worker and your child has been attending school already, we will keep these places but kindly ask you to bring your child to school each day for the remaining days left this term.

Please contact us on Wednesday between 9am – 12pm and 1pm – 4pm to request a place. You can contact school on 01902742686 and select option 2.

Once we have identified the number of children requiring a place in school, we will contact parents with further plans. This may be an offer of selected weeks in school or half days, depending on the uptake. Please note, to adhere to social distancing, we will have to ensure class sizes do not exceed 15 children and therefore we may not be able to offer all children a place. Children with an EHCP, social worker or those who are considered to be vulnerable will be allocated as priority.

Please note due to Y4 transition to Perton Middle School, we will be closed to Y4 pupils on Wednesday 1<sup>st</sup> July.
