

## Wider Reopening of School

Dear Parent,

Thank you for expressing an interest in your child returning to school for the remaining weeks left in the summer term. As you will appreciate there was much demand for children to spend some time back in school. Based on the number of places requested, we are able to offer children one week in school to be taught within their current year group.

To adhere to government guidelines, there are a number of measures that we have put in place to keep the children, parents and staff safe. These include:

- Children being taught in small groups of up to 15 pupils
- Classrooms set up to ensure social distancing
- Children receiving their own equipment to use which remains in their designated workspace
- Regular handwashing throughout the day
- Designated areas on the playground to use for break and lunch times
- Staggered arrival and dismissal times to limit numbers of people on the school site
- Additional cleaning throughout the day

Your child will be able to attend school for **one week from Monday 22<sup>nd</sup> June** within the Y2 class group. Please use the Base 10 entrance (at the side of the main carpark) and arrive at 8.45am. The class will be dismissed from this door at 3.05pm. Please be considerate and maintain social distancing when dropping off and collecting children. Children will need to bring their lunch and a water bottle into school.

Please be aware, school will close at 12.45pm on Friday 26<sup>th</sup> June for deep cleaning and children will need collecting at this time.

We are looking forward to welcoming the children back into school for this short period of time. If you have any concerns, please do not hesitate to contact us.
