Dear All

School will be open for all children from Wednesday, 2 September. It is expected that all children will be in attendance.

In order to support your child and the school, we ask that parents:

- Ensure that they only bring essential items into school. This will include their coat, packed lunch, water bottle, reading record and reading book.
(Please note: children in reception, year 1, year 2 and those entitled to free school meals will be provided with a daily hot meal and where possible should not bring a packed lunch into school.)
- Ensure that children do not bring in any toys, bikes or footballs from home.
- Collect their child, punctually from their designated drop off and collection point around the school site. Details below.

Nursery - 8:45am – 11:45am
12:15pm – 3:15pm

Children will come in and be dismissed from the Nursery gate.

- **Fridays** – all of school, including Nursery, will continue to close at 1pm so that a deep clean can take place. However, children can remain at school until 3pm for Homework Club.
- Children should come to school in their PE kits and remain in them for the whole day on their designated PE day. You will be advised of this when we return to school in September.
- Keep to social distancing guidelines where possible when on the school site.
- Where possible, only one adult to accompany their child to school. This includes families who have more than one child attending our school.
- Where possible, pass messages to school via Dojo rather than speaking to an adult on the gate.
- Send children into school in their full school uniform.
- Make sure that the office has up to date contact details. This includes mobile phone numbers, email and home addresses.
