Transition Arrangements

We have been working hard to plan transition arrangements to ensure children get some time to meet their new teacher and spend time in their new classroom. Although school is closed to pupils on our Inset Day on 3rd July, we would like to invite children in to begin transition.

In your child's report, you will have two letters. One letter is from Ms Small informing you of your child's class teacher for next year. You will also receive a letter informing you of their transition group for the remaining Friday mornings left in school (3rd July, 10th July, 17th July).

Children should only attend for their transition session and will not be in school all day.

On these days, we have a **very limited** number of places for key workers from 8.45 - 1pm on these days. If you **urgently** require a place, please contact the school office asap. Once these places are full, we will not be able to take any more children.

We hope these sessions will help support the children in transitioning to the next stage in their education.
