Pick up and collection times: From Monday 8th March, all children will return to school, as announced this week. From this date, the collection and drop off times shall be as follows:

If your child is not attending homework club on a Friday, then please use the following collection time: 1pm (Surnames A-G), 1.05pm (Surnames H-N) or 1.10pm (Surnames O-Z). Please adhere to these times where possible and ensure you maintain social distance.

The Government guidance states that adults should wear face coverings on school sites where social distancing between adults is not possible. We have been asked to remind all parents to wear face coverings when they cannot maintain social distancing. This does include parents of children in nursery and preschool.

We would like to request that any parent entering the school building also wears a face covering.

Can we also ask that you:

- leave the site promptly upon collection of your child and do not arrive at school early and wait at the school gate
- collect your child from their designated drop off and collection points around the school site. You will be notified of your drop off and collection point by your child's class teacher.
- keep to social distancing guidelines when on the school site.
- only use one adult per family to drop off and collect children from school.
- pass messages to school via Dojo or use the post box next to reception rather than speaking to an adult on the gate.

Parking: Please be considerate to our neighbours when parking on the road.

The main car park is for staff parking only and children who have restricted mobility.
