A retrieval task weekly or fortnightly so children can constantly revisit and interrupt the forgetting curve.

Each year group has a map of the world displayed in their area. These are used for identifying where the stories we read are from.

Use of pupil voice to ensure the children are able to explain their learning using appropriate vocabulary.

Knowledge organisers and question sheets, to start each topic.
