

Both our structured and unstructured curriculum support safeguarding through PSHE, Computing and E-Safety, Picture News, British Values, Road Safety, Well-Being Ambassadors, Assemblies and workshops from the NSPCC.

DSL and DDSL's have undertaken training and regular attend updates. The DSL also attends an annual safeguarding conference.

The Senior Leadership Team and several governors are trained in Safer Recruitment Practices.

Staff inductions involve comprehensive safeguarding procedures.

Single Central Record to record details of safeguarding checks that have been carried out for every member of staff and other relevant people.

Daily, weekly and half termly monitoring of attendance. First day calls and close liaison with EWO. Follow procedures for CME.

Policies and code of conduct in place for staff and visitors to follow.

Robust end of day procedures to ensure that children are collected by a nominated adult.

All staff, governors and volunteers undertake level one safeguarding, FGM and Prevent training. Annual safeguarding refresher, staff INSETs, weekly staff briefing questions and quizzes.

My Concern secure online system for monitoring child protection, safeguarding, pastoral or welfare concerns.

IT firewall to safeguard children using technology. SENSO is used to monitor adult and child use. Alerts are sent to SLT to inform them of any online risks.

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
